<u>*Please label all costumes/shoes/tights/etc. with the dancer's name – everyone's</u> look exactly the same and a name goes a long way toward keeping things from getting mixed up!

Shoes:	Girls : Bloch Giselle SO249G Pink leather ballet shoes Boys : Capezio Black leather ballet shoes
Tights:	Girls : Ballet Pink Capezio 1816 or 1816C tights Boys : N/A
Hair:	Girls : Straight back, high bun. Do the hair wet and use gel and hairspray to slick back stray hairs or wispys. Use a hairnet and hairpins both the color of your dancer's hair to secure the bun. Attach the flower hairpiece to upper leftside of the dancer's bun. Boys : Groomed and neat
Makeup	Think natural colors but apply much darker than street makeup to help the dancer's features really stand out under the harsh stage lights. Please use all of the following types of makeup to create a complete stage look: foundation to match the dancer's skin, blush to compliment the dancer's own skin tone, black WATERPROOF eyeliner and mascara. Eye shadow colors should be in earthy colored tones dark enough to make the eyes pop (but no blue eye shadow). Lipstick color should be a deep plum/reddish purple/burgundy color- no fire engine red. Be sure to finish your dancer's makeup with an application of face powder. Powder helps set the makeup, keeping it in place and looking fresher longer. No fingernail polish!

Costume description:	Girls : Mint green leotard with attached leotard and flower details Boys : Khaki jogger pants with mint green button down short sleeve top and bowtie
Costume Instructions:	Hang up all costume pieces to allow any wrinkles to fall out, otherwise, nothing should need to be done to the dancer's costume
